He recently successfully represented a trustee in a "momentous decision" application before the Royal Court which involved AML considerations.

His data protection practice encompasses drafting terms and conditions, policies and procedures and advising on incident responses and international transfers. He has presented on the implementation of the forthcoming GDPR and is at the forefront of considering its implementation in Guernsey.

He has spoken publicly on regulatory matters, authored articles on data protection, litigation developments, Guernsey's AML regime and Alderney's eGaming regime and produced guideline notes on Guernsey's data protection laws.
